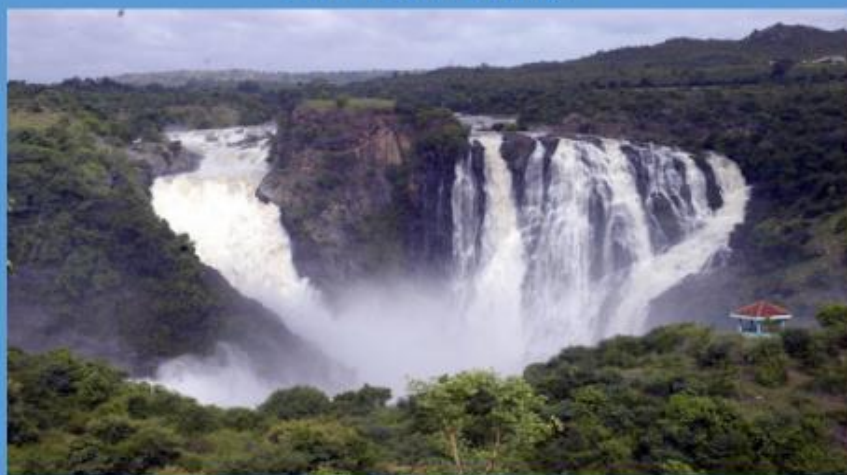

From Principal Director's Desk



I take great pleasure in bringing out the second edition of the newsletter for the period from May 2022 to September 2022 showcasing the initiatives and achievements of Regional Training Centre, Bengaluru.

During the above period, RTC Bengaluru has conducted Twelve (12) General Courses with 229 participants, Four (4) IT courses with 63 participants and a National seminar on "Cybersecurity" with 232 participants as per the COTP approved by Training Wing, Delhi. The training courses/sessions on audit, soft skills and several extra-curricular activities were also conducted. Apart from approved COTP, one additional Induction training programme for Direct Recruit Assistant Audit officers from 11/07/2022 to 30/09/2022.

The Mid Career Training Programme (MCTP) Level 2 (3 Batches) and MCTP 3 (1 Batch) has been conducted successfully. The participants were taken on field visits to institutions like IIM, Bangalore, IISC-Shivanahalli, Bangalore, IIFR, Hesarghatta, Bangalore, and NDRI, Bangalore.

*The trainees and staff of RTC Bangalore participated on the occasion of World Environment Day on 6th June 2022. Saplings of **Champaka** and **Mango** were planted in the premises of RTC Bengaluru and the staff took an oath that they would be using public transport at least twice in a month so as to avoid carbon footprints.*

The training centre celebrated "World Yoga Day" on 27th June 2022. An external faculty and "Yoga instructor" from Art of Living Foundation, explained the benefits of yoga in day to day life. All the staff along with participants did simple yoga and breathing exercises. There was an excellent feedback by all the participants.

*RTC Bengaluru has made efforts to impart quality training to its trainees. The participants of ongoing Induction training to DRAAOs, were taken to **Sports Authority of India, Bengaluru** where the young officers learnt about International standards in Sports training, Athletic medical health check-up process, their diet and nutrition. Further, the trainees were taken on field trips to **Bangalore Creative Circus, Art of Living Centre, Karnataka Chitrakala Parishath** to gain experience in cultural fields. Sessions on Badminton games were organised to boost their sport spirit.*

I thank all the user offices for their continued support and cooperation in enabling this office to achieve all its endeavours. I also take this opportunity to thank and appreciate the efforts taken by the faculties and staff of RTC for smooth functioning of this office.

GENERAL COURSES

Local language

Training on Local language was conducted for 21 participants from 09/05/2022 to 13/05/2022. Basics of Kannada-Writing, reading and Grammar was taught. Role play on Kannada conversation was done by the participants.

e-office (Batch-1)

An online course on e-office (Batch-1) was conducted for 22 participants on 17/05/2022. Introduction to e-office administration, file Management system were taught by a resource person from Headquarters.

GeM Procurement and Inventory Management

A training on GeM Procurement and Inventory Management was conducted on 20/05/2022 for 19 participants. Inventory Management along with Public procurement policies, procurement of goods, Works and services, procurement in Government e-Market portal were explained with case studies.

Mid Career Training Programme (MCTP)

As per instructions of Training Wing a MCTP for AAOs who have put in 7 years or more service are to be conducted in

RTC Bengaluru. Various topics including Soft skills-Group Dynamics, Team Management, Personality, Morale issues, Motivation, Gender Sensitization and Prevention of Sexual Harassment at Workplace Act, 2013 were covered in MCTP courses. Career development core topics like Public finance, Environmental topics and advanced concepts of Information systems are also covered during the training.

MCTP Level 2 (Batch1) from 24/05/2022 to 31/05/2022 for 23 AAOs. The participants were taken for a Field visit to *Indian Institute of Management – Business, Bangalore*.

MCTP Level 2 (Batch 2) was conducted from 20/06/2022 to 27/06/2022 for 21 AAOs.

The participants enacted a role play on, based on a case study on Industrial development in forest land. They were divided into groups consisting officials of Forest Department, Urban Development Authority and Citizen Forum for discussion of environmental issues and sustained development on the topic.

The participants were taken on a Field visit to *Indian Institute of Horticultural Research, Hesaraghatta, Bengaluru*. Agricultural Scientists shared their knowledge and experience. The trainees

went around the farm maintained by the Research Institute and learnt about their significant activities.

MCTP Level 2 (Batch 3) was conducted from 19/09/2022 to 26/09/2022 where 17 AAOs participated in the training.

Ms. Sarasu Thomas, Professor from National Law School handled sessions on Gender Sensitization and POSH act, 2013.

Sri. D J Bhadra, IA&AS, ADAI (Retd.) handled the sessions on Effective Communication during the Training.

The participants were taken on a field visit to *National Dairy Research Institute, Bengaluru*. The participants were made aware of the Research activities of the NDRI, Bangalore. The participants visited the processing units and the Cow shelters in the campus

MCTP Level 3 (Batch 1)

MCTP Level 3 (Batch 1) from 06/06/2022 to 13/06/2022 for 21 AAOs/SAOs.

The participants were taken on a field visit to *Rama Krishna Mission, Shivanahalli*, where two sessions were handled by Mr. T V Ramachandra, renowned Environmentalist along with his team members. They imparted lectures on Environmental issues viz plants, trees,

birds and pollution, etc. The Ashram has created mini-forest by planting different varieties of trees and plants, which are of herbal importance which was a natural habitat for different varieties of birds and animals.

GST

GST course was held for 16 participants from 04/07/2022 to 08/07/2022. The target group included Auditors/Accountants and above. Ms Sabrina Cano, a GST trainer and Presidential award winner for distinguished service in 2014, delivered lecture on '*Demands & Recovery, Offences & penalties, Appeals & Revision*' to the participants.

Office Procedure

Office Procedure including Noting and drafting was held from 18/07/2022 to 20/07/2022 for 18 participants from all cadres. Administrative topics like, TA/LTC rules, Conduct rules, Legal Issues, Disciplinary issues, etc. were imparted in the training.

Administrative Issues (Batch 1)

Administrative Issues (Batch 1) was conducted from 16/08/2022 to 19/08/2022 for 16 participants. The sessions on various administrative topics like CCS (CCA) Rules, Conduct Rules, Pension Rules, TA & LTC rules, Leave

Rules, Pay Rules, working in e-Office, PFMS & IBEMS, etc., were handled by faculties.

Office Procedure including Noting and drafting

Office Procedure including Noting and drafting from 07/09/2022 to 09/09/2022 for 17 participants. Topics like, TA/LTC rules, Conduct rules, Legal Issues, Disciplinary issues, etc.

Sri. D J Bhadra, IA&AS, Retd. ADAI, O/o C&AG of India, handled sessions on communication skills during the training.

Induction Training for Direct Recruit AAOs

The Induction training for 15 Direct Recruit AAOs of CGLE Batch 2018, from 11/07/2022 to 30/09/2022. During the training many sessions on Core Curricular topics, Soft skills, extra-curricular activities such as meditation & Yoga sessions, musical programme involving the participants were imparted.

The participants were assigned a project of formulating Performance Audit Guidelines for upcoming PA topics provided by the Audit I and Audit II Offices. Four Teams were formed and were given topics viz.,

(i) Disaster Management in the State of Karnataka

- (ii) Functioning with respecting to Licensing, Renewal of State Excise Department and Micro Breweries in Karnataka
- (iii) Preservation and Conservation of State protected Historical Monuments and Antiquities in Karnataka,
- (iv) Execution of Road Maintenance Works in Nort-East Zone of Public Works Department

Sri. D J Bhadra, IA&AS, ADAI (Retd.) handled the sessions on “Communication Basics” during the training.

A combined session on “Geographical Information System / Remote Sensing” was handled by Sri. Mallesh Ballina, Group Manager-Pre Sales and Ms. Roma Malik, Pre Sales Engineer from Environmental Systems Research Institute, Bangalore, for Mid-Career Training programme Level 2 Batch 3 and Induction Training for Direct Recruit Assist Audit Officers on 26/09/2022.

Extra curricular activities:

- **Musical Afternoon:** on 29/07/2022 the participants sang Bollywood numbers as a part of Antyakshari event.
- **Book Club:** Participants discussed on the book “Everyone Loves a Good

Draught” written by Sri. P Sainath on 26/07/2022

- **Art and Craft** session was held by Ms. Tejeswini K, Art Exponent on 16/08/2022.

Field visits:

- **Sports:** The participants were taken to **Sports Authority of India, Bangalore** on 22/07/2022.

Ms. Marry Rani, Taekwondo expert and many coaches from various streams of sports, viz., Badminton, Table Tennis, Shuttle cock, Gun-shooting, etc., gave bird’s eye view on the streams for which they are coaching.

- **Art of Living International centre** on 18/08/2022 where sessions on Meditation and pranayama and a campus visit was done.
- **Sports practice:** The participants were taken to **Ballals Badminton Arena** for playing shuttle badminton on 22/08/2022.

- A **Sound Walk to Karnataka Chitra Kala Parishat**, Bengaluru was arranged on 02/09/2022. The participants visited Art Museum and Roriech Art Gallery in the premises.
- **Bangalore Creative Circus**, was visited on 06/09/2022. Modelled as an Urban Living Lab, BCC is a platform where businesses, leaders, and change makers can collaborate, design, experiment, innovate, and showcase. It is a space where consumers can find access to knowledge, solutions, services, and community, all under one roof. The participants had valuable experience on *Permaculture*, about how water can be recycled using it for gardening and growing organic vegetables/greens for consumption, etc. A session on “Climate Change” was handled at the campus by the co-founder of the “Bangalore Creative Circus”.

IT COURSES

MS- Excel

MS Excel Classes were conducted from 06.06.2022 to 10.06.2022. There were 17 participants from different user offices. The sessions included topics on Formulas, Filters, Functions, Formatting techniques, Creation of Pivot Tables, charts etc.

Data analysis in Oracle

OIOS Mobile app

What is the OIOS Mobile app?

The OIOS Mobile app is an application available for all OIOS users with a valid account.

The app provides facility


- to scan documents and convert them to PDF format
- capture images and videos
- upload images and videos already stored in Gallery
- fill responses of toolkits

What are its advantages?

The app does not use storage space of the mobile of the user. The scanned documents, images etc uploaded from the app are stored in a work space allocated for the user in the server. The user is not required to connect the mobile to a desktop or laptop to transfer the scanned documents.

How to access the app?

- Download the OIOS app from Mobile stores. Check for the CAG logo while downloading.
- Login to the OIOS app using the same credentials that you would use in a laptop/desktop.

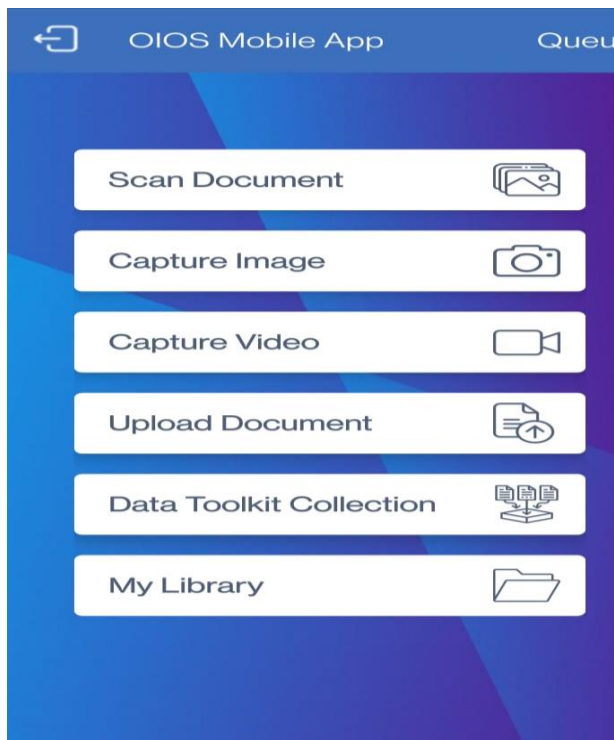

Menus in OIOS Mobile app



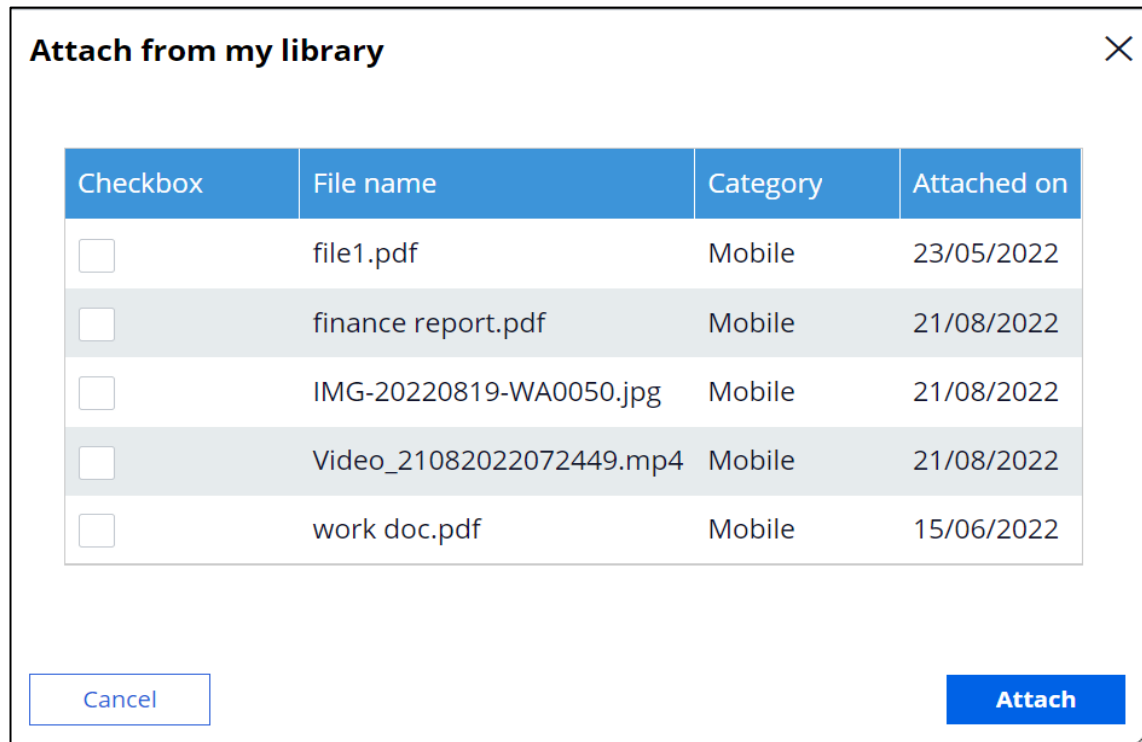
- **Scan Document:** This menu uses the mobile camera to scan documents, format them and combine them into a pdf file before uploading the file to the OIOS server.
- **Capture Image:** The menu helps users to capture images using the mobile camera and upload them to the OIOS server. Images already available in the gallery may also be uploaded to OIOS server.
- **Capture Video:** The menu helps users to capture videos using the mobile camera and upload them to the OIOS server. Videos already available in the gallery may also be uploaded to OIOS server.

- **Upload document:** Documents in the mobile can be uploaded to the server using this menu.
- **Data Toolkit Collection:** Using this menu, users can fill toolkits linked to their field visits and submit them.
- **My Library:** This feature provides the user with the facility to view, download and delete the documents uploaded in the server through the OIOS Mobile app.

How to access the documents stored in My Library during audit/vetting?

While attaching key documents, users may choose Attach from My Library. The documents scanned through the mobile app (and not deleted) would be listed. The user can select the required documents and upload them.

Points to be noted:

- Only the documents uploaded by the user through the mobile app would be listed in 'My Library' of the user.
- Documents uploaded by other audit party members, using their login id, would not be visible to an user. After the Key document is uploaded to a Field visit from 'My Library' by a field party member, other members of the Field party can access it.
- Officials in QA/QC, DP and Reports wings may also use the app to scan and upload documents.
- The size of a single file can be upto 100 MB. One can upload any number of documents to the server using the OIOS mobile app.
